

I understand that <u>Lanakila Baptist Schools</u> does not discriminate in its employment practices against any person because of race, color, national or ethnic origin, gender, age, or qualified disability.

I hereby certify that the facts set forth in this application process are true and complete to the best of my knowledge. I understand that falsification of any statement or a significant omission of fact may prevent me from being hired, or if hired, may subject me to immediate dismissal regardless of the time

elapsed before discovery. If I am released under these circumstances, I further understand and agree that I will be paid and receive benefits only through the day of release.

I authorize <u>Lanakila Baptist Schools</u> to thoroughly interview the primary references which I have listed, any secondary references mentioned through interviews with primary references, or other individuals who know me and have knowledge regarding my testimony and work record. I also authorize the school to thoroughly investigate my work records and evaluations, my educational preparation, and other matters related to my suitability for the position.

I authorize references and my former employers to disclose to the school any and all employment records, performance reviews, letters, reports, and other information related to my life and employment, without giving me prior notice of such disclosure. In addition, I hereby release the school, my former employers, references, and all other parties from any and all claims, demands, or liabilities arising out of or in any way related to such investigation or disclosure. I waive the right to ever personally view any references given to the school.

Since I will be working with children, I understand that I must submit to a fingerprint check by the FBI and possibly other federal and state authorities. I agree to fully cooperate in providing and recording as many sets of my fingerprints as are necessary for such an investigation. I authorize the school to conduct a criminal records check. I understand and agree that any offer of employment that I may receive from the school is conditioned upon the receipt of background information, including criminal background information. The school may refuse employment or terminate conditional employment if the school deems any background information unfavorable or that it could reflect adversely on the school or on me as a Christian role model.

Lanakila Baptist Schools STATEMENT OF FAITH

We Believe ...

> That the Holy Scriptures were given by inspiration of God, that they are complete and without error or omission, to be accepted and interpreted literally, except in those places

- where the context clearly indicates otherwise. Further, for reasons of unity and consistency, we use the King James Version in our church and school classrooms.
- ➤ In one God, eternally existing and manifesting Himself to mankind as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- That the Genesis account of creation is to be understood and interpreted as literal truth, that God created this world and all its inhabitants (species) in six, 24-hour days. We further reject all preconceptions, assumptions and speculations belonging to the theory of "macro" evolution or any of its diverse variants.
- First the Lord Jesus Christ pre-existed His birth in Bethlehem, was begotten of the Holy Spirit, born of a virgin lived throughout His life without sin, was sacrificed on a cross as the substitutionary blood-atonement for all and rose again physical from the dead to offer eternal life to all men and women who will receive His gift of salvation.
- In the free gift of salvation offered to all, yet inasmuch as man has been endowed by His creator with a free will, he may choose to accept or reject that salvation. We further believe that once a person has accepted God's gift of salvation, he or she is from that moment eternally secure, hidden in and kept by Christ, never to be lost.
- That Jesus Christ ascended back to heaven following His resurrection, where He now acts as the believer's Mediator and Advocate. We further believe in the imminent return of Christ for the purposes of gathering His believers off the earth at the Rapture, after which He will return physically to rule and reign as King of kings from Jerusalem.
- That the Hebrew nation of Israel still retains an essential and integral part in the prophetic promises and program of God's Word. That America will be blessed by God in direct proportion to its understanding and acceptance of Israel's special place in the heart of God.
- In the present regenerative and intercessory activities of the Holy Spirit in behalf of those who accept the salvation of god through Christ. That He bestows ministerial gifts upon believers in order that they may better serve the ministries of Christ's church body. We further assert that we will not subscribe to nor all the promotion of those commonly associated with the modern Charismatic movement's abuse of God's precious spiritual gifts.
- > That the local church exists, in all of its various ministries, to draw sinners to and point a lost mankind to Jesus. This church functions with Christ as its head and its leaders chosen by the local body of believers. Further, by New Testament command, practices two ordinances ordained by Christ, water baptism by immersion in obedience to Jesus and the memorial observances of the Lord's Supper.

Lanakila Baptist Schools is a ministry of the Lanakila Baptist Church. As such, its Faculty must also be Baptists of like faith, active in both attendance and ministry participation at Lanakila.
