LBS Summer Enrichment Program Policies

AGREEMENT

- The Enrollment Fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE** and must be paid in advance before you are placed on the Summer School Enrollment List.
- **Early Registration** for LBES students will begin **today- May 1, 2019**. Once the class is filled, we will place students on the waiting list with a \$125 enrollment fee. If not selected by June 1, 2019, your enrollment fee will be refunded.
- I give permission for my child's image or photo to be used for promotional material for Lanakila Baptist Schools
- Students who choose not to follow the Dress Code or Student Code of Conduct may be dismissed from the program with no refund.

DRESS CODE POLICY & STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

All **students** enrolled in the LBES Summer Enrichment Program **are allowed to wear regular clothes to school** however, students are asked that their attire should be modest, loose fitting, and in good repair. Shorts should be modest and loose fitting, and should not be shorter than mid-thigh. Sagging pants or exposed underwear will not be allowed. Pants must fit properly. Shirts should not have any prints that promote violence, drug use, or obscene, vulgar, or inappropriate language that would be offensive to others. Additionally, **PLEASE no leggings or tight-fitting pants/shorts unless t-shirt covers the torso and buttocks.** (Lanakila Baptist Schools reserves the right to deem any clothing inappropriate.) Tennis shoes/sneakers must be worn **ONLY**.

* **Swim Day:** Students may appropriate swim wear i.e. rash guards & board shorts in the water. **NO** Bikinis allowed unless under clothing.

The **Student Code of Conduct** will remain as stated in the current Lanakila Baptist Elementary Student Handbook and will be strictly enforced.

Lanakila Baptist Schools – Has **ZERO** Tolerance for Bullying, **RESPECT** at all times, **OBEYS** Authority, **ASK** Permission always, and **HAS FUN!**

MEDICAL CARE AUTHORIZATION

I/we request that the school contact me/us. If the school cannot reach a parent/guardian after conscientious effort, I/we give permission for school staff to call paramedics or any licensed physician or dentist. If life-threatening emergency exists, I/we give permission for school staff to call paramedics immediately and then contact me/us as soon as possible thereafter.

It is understood that effort shall be made to contact the undersigned prior to rendering treatment to the student, but that any of the above treatment will not be withheld if the undersigned or authorized adults cannot be reached.

I/we understand that the school does not provide accident/medical insurance for students, and I/we further understand that all costs related to medical treatment may be my/our responsibility and not that of the school district. If my child needs to be taken to an emergency facility, he/she will be taken to the nearest one. I give my consent for school authorities to take appropriate action for the safety and welfare of my child. (If living with both parents, both signatures are requested.)

OFF CAMPUS EXCURSIONS RELEASE

I give my permission for my child to participate in all school-sponsored trips away from the school premises throughout the current summer enrichment program. Students will be accompanied by a teacher and will be under adequate supervision. I understand that I will be given at least 48 hours' notice of all trips away from the school premises. I further understand that I may revoke permission for a specific field trip by written notice hand delivered to the school office more than one day prior to the trip.

Although the school desires to provide a safe and enjoyable time for all students, accidents can still happen. I/We understand that there are risks/dangers involved with participation in off-campus trips and their associated activities. In consideration of my child being allowed to participate in this event, I/we assume responsibility for those ordinary and reasonable risks associated with the travel and activities. I/we agree to hold harmless Lanakila Baptist Schools, its affiliated organizations, employees, agents, and representatives, including volunteer and other drivers, from any and all claims arising from my child's participation. This release agreement does not apply to claims of intentional (criminal) misconduct or gross negligence by the school, its employees, or volunteers. If such circumstances are proved in a court of law, I/we acknowledge and agree that the school can assume no financial liability beyond its actual liability insurance policy in force.
